☀ **Supplies:**

Each bag takes on average only 1 hour to make

For one bag you will need:

- ✂ Outside of bag: 2 fat quarters cut into TWO -9x12 pieces
- ✂ Lining: 2 fat quarters – cut into TWO -9x12 pieces
- ✂ 2 yards of silk or craft cord – Michaels has a wonderful pack in the bead section with a variety of 4 colors
- ✂ 1 seam ripper
- ✂ Rotary cutter and scissors
- ✂ A couple of large safety pins
- ✂ You can bring your own sewing machine or Capital Vac and Sew will Provide the Pfaff sewing machines, & cutting & ironing stations

You might have time to make 2 bags, so feel free to bring extra supplies for another bag
